Katie Spellman is a research associate at IARC. Spellman works with collaborators to increase diverse participation in citizen science. One focus is to collaborate with citizen scientists to monitor resources like berries that are important to Alaskans.

Ryan Toohey is a scientist with the USGS Alaska Climate Adaptation Science Center. Toohey assists the Indigenous Observation Network in water quality and permafrost research. He also focuses on involving multi-stakeholders in stream temperature monitoring efforts, community participation in climate adaptation planning, and developing user-friendly tools to visualize data and increase research capacity.
